Paragraphing and punctuation are added by editor to make the meaning clear. Italics are used to insert information in the text of a letter, such as "(sic)" for errors of writer not corrected, or an explanation of who a person is, or a full name. Bold type is used to select from the text a name or idea the editor thought important. "?" means editor is unsure of word (s) meaning. A "\*" means editor made copy of letter.
