\*Prior to Fall 1999, the total "On Campus" count was generally used in state and federal reporting. Beginning in Fall 1999, the "Grand Total All Students" was used in state and federal reporting, to bring external reporting in line with the study abroad payment policy change. Beginning in 2016, under new federal guidance, the total "On Campus" count is again generally being used for state and federal reporting.

\*\*Enrollments and enrollment patterns impacted by COVID. In Fall 2020, "On Campus" could indicate that students were studying on campus *or* taking Swarthmore classes remotely. See Fact Book page "Students Living on Campus" for the number physically on campus in fall terms.
